INVITATION TO TENDER

Dear Sir/Madam,

The Findhorn, Nairn, and Lossie Rivers Trust (FNLRT) invites your submission of a tender to provide services in accordance with the scope of work detailed below.

TENDER B: Aerial Survey Upper River Findhorn catchment

1. Scope of work –

To provide a full digital aerial survey of the Upper Findhorn catchment with particular attention to the river and its tributaries. The digital aerial surveys will provide photographic data on land form, river morphology and tree cover for the upper catchment, inform the prioritisation of nature restoration activities for the Findhorn Watershed Initiative, and provide baseline documentation for the project.

- 2. Outputs
 - a. High quality digital aerial photographs showing existing vegetation cover and river course
 - b. Integrated the photo survey with ESRI ArcGIS mapping platform in coordination with GIS contractor
 - c. Report on the baseline status 'before' photography
 - d. Collect video imagery for general scenic views and communications materials
- Timeframes Work to be invoiced before 31 March 2023, and completed by 30 April 2023
- 4. Location Upper Findhorn Catchment; from Coignafearn to Drynachan (Map 1)

This scope of work contributes towards a wider project – the <u>Findhorn Watershed Initiative</u> (FWI) – a landscape-scale vision for ecological restoration in the River Findhorn catchment. Advice gathered and surveys undertaken will inform the prioritisation of intervention areas going forward, and equip the FNL Rivers Trust with the information to implement a highly strategic, efficient and effective delivery phase of the project. Your tender response should be submitted by email to Elle Adams at <u>elle@fnlrt.org.uk</u> by **17.00 Friday 17 March 2023**. We ask you to please provide both an outline of how you would go about delivering the tender outputs, as well as costings. Please note that submission of bids does not create any obligation on the Findhorn, Nairn, and Lossie Rivers Trust to award the contract, or to award it to the lowest bidder.

FNLRT welcomes submissions of a combined bid from any Bidder who wishes to deliver services for multiple open tenders as one contract of work.

The Bidder must make any Alternative Offer in a separate letter to accompany the Tender explaining the reasoning behind the proposed alternative approach. The Trust is under no obligation to accept Alternative Offers.


The service provision shall be effective immediately on signing the contract. All work should be completed by 31 May 2023.
